Our Reporting to You

As a reminder, especially for our new parents/caregivers, since 2021, we no longer provide traditional formal written reports mid-year and end-of-year.

Covering all curriculum areas over time, our reporting is now through our learning sharing app, **Seesaw** which we expect that you have all downloaded and accessed frequently to see what's going on in your child's class via regular teacher and student posts.

If you need help here, please ask.

During the year, there are various milestone reporting dates when more formal learning is shared with you. At the end of Term 2 (next week) and possibly early on in the holidays, all teachers will be reporting on your child's learning and curriculum achievement levels in the areas of:

- Writing (a writing sample)




