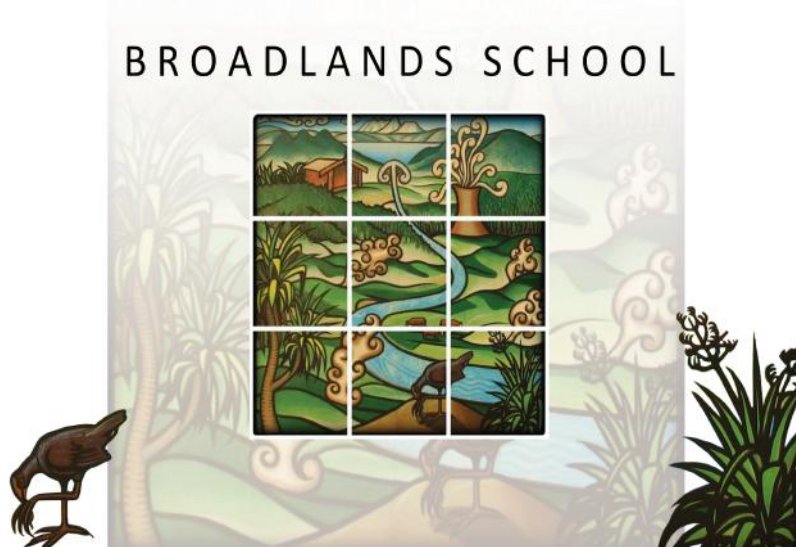

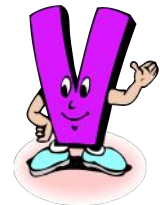

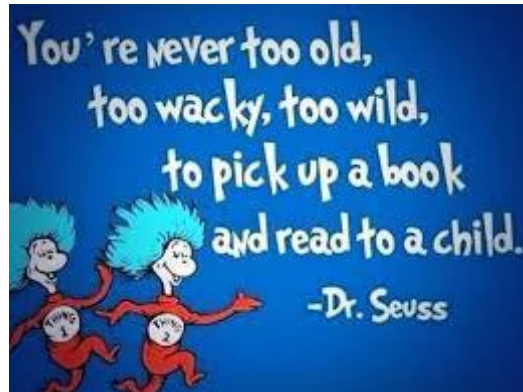

The first class will start **Tuesday 5 November**.

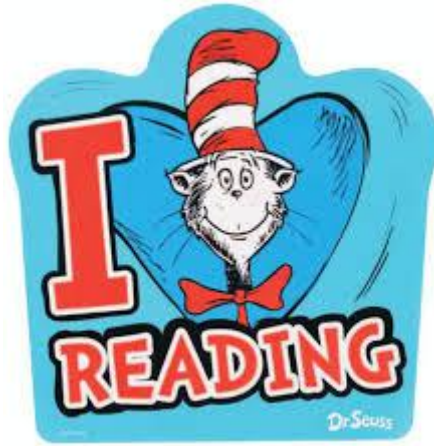
